Motion carried unanimously.

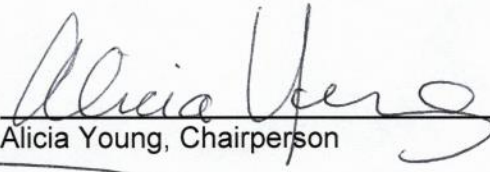
E. ADJOURNMENT
