Motion carried unanimously.

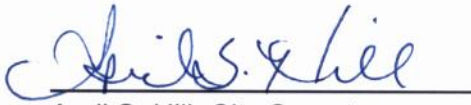

Motion made by Victor Molaschi second by John Thompson to approve Order 2022-02-15-001 ordering a Special Election to be held on the 7th day of May, 2022, for the purpose of submitting to the qualified voters of the proposed district comprising the City of Roanoke, Texas, a ballot proposition to adopt a Sales and Use Tax for the proposed district at the rate of one-half of one percent dedicated to Crime Control and Prevention Programs, contingent upon the eligible voters of the City of Roanoke, Texas, voting to repeal the Type B Economic Development Sales Tax; designating the places and manner of holding said election; providing a summary of the proposed budget plan and crime control plan.
